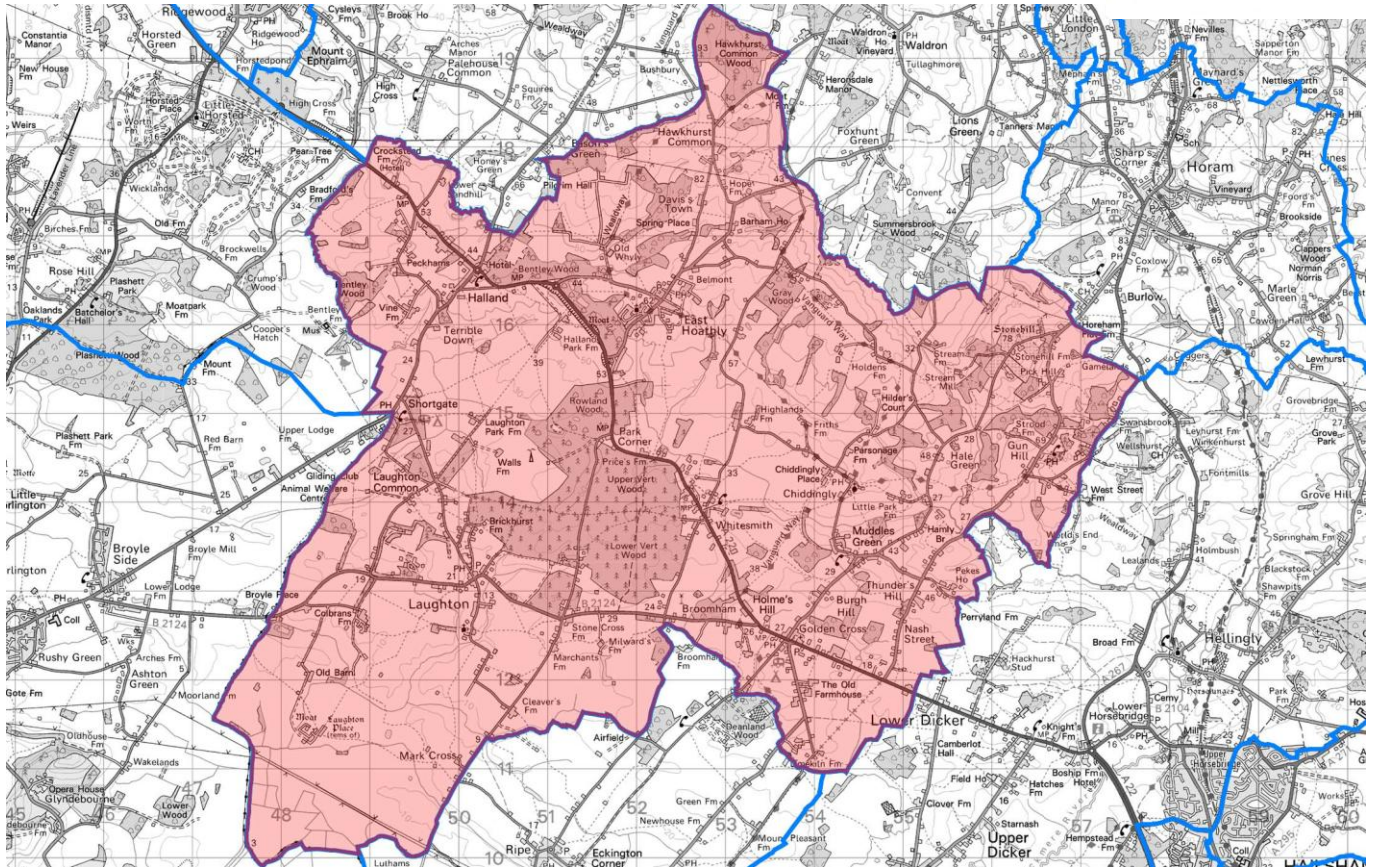


Chiddingly and East Hoathly Ward profile

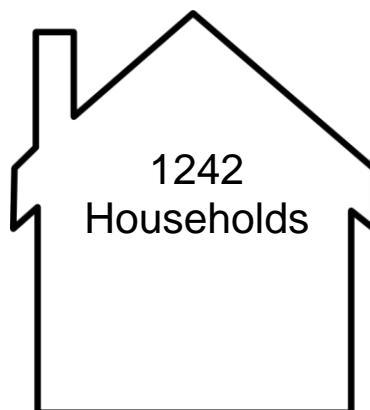

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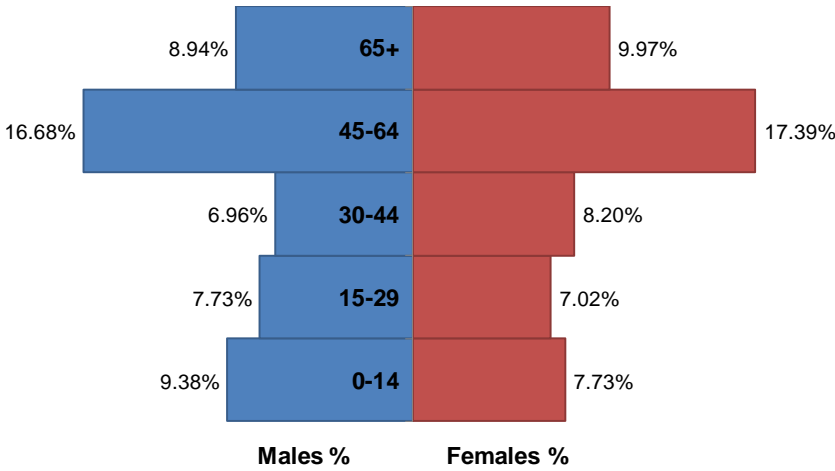

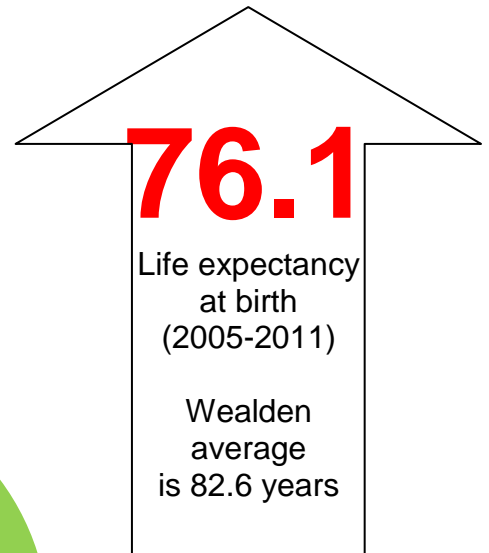
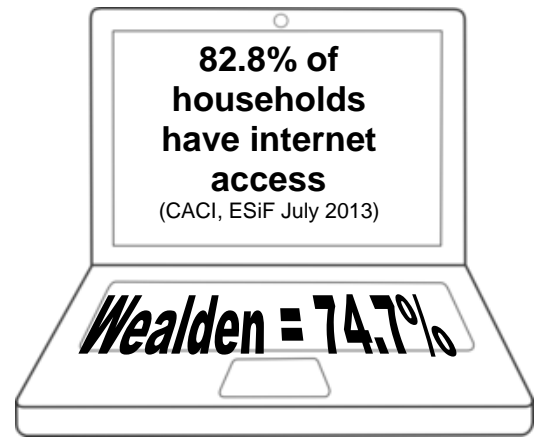
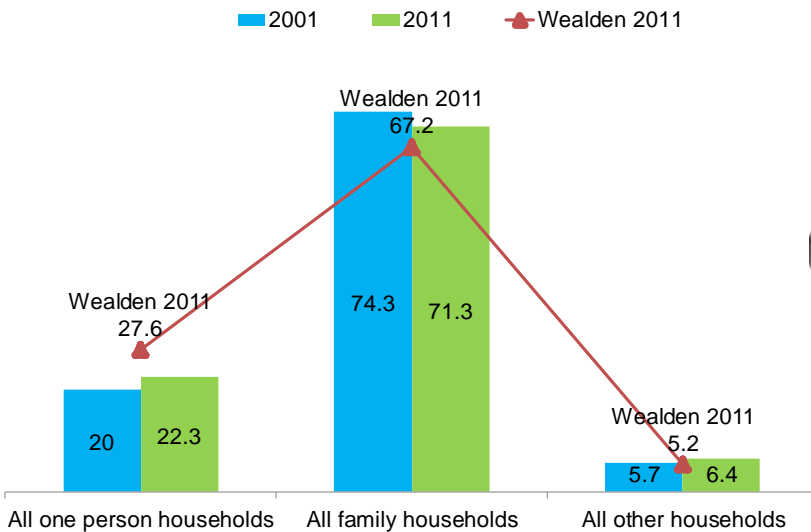
Population by Age and Gender

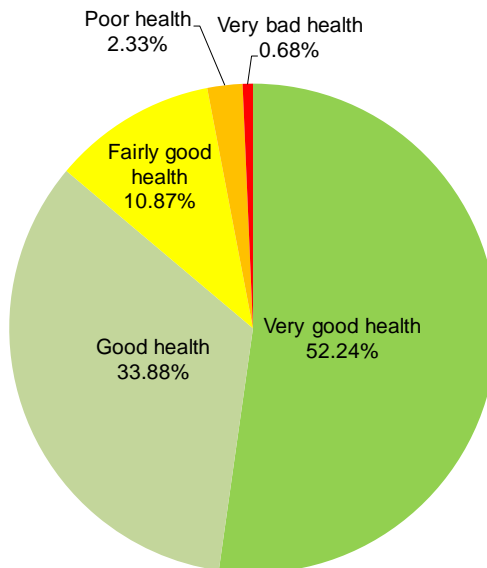
Household Composition in 2001 and 2011 (%)

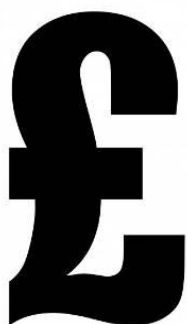

The highest level of educational qualification achieved by the biggest group of Chiddingly and East Hoathly residents (35.4%) is Level 4 qualifications and above.

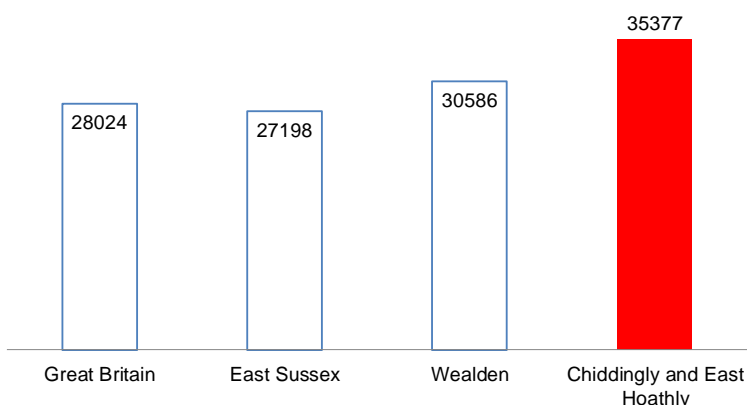
This is significantly higher compared with the 28.9% of residents aged 16 and over in Wealden with Level 4 qualifications and above.

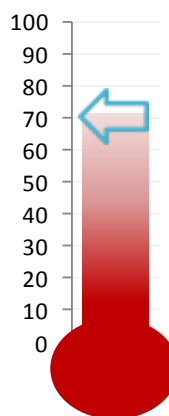
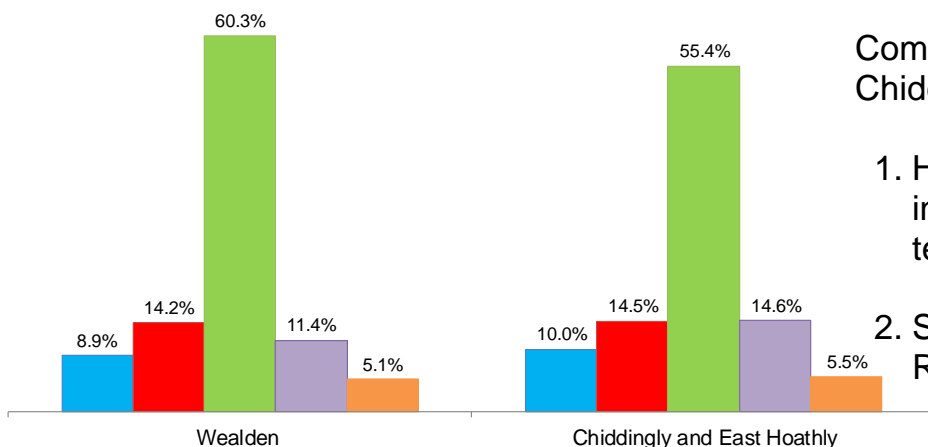


Economic Activity

2. Slightly smaller % of Retired.



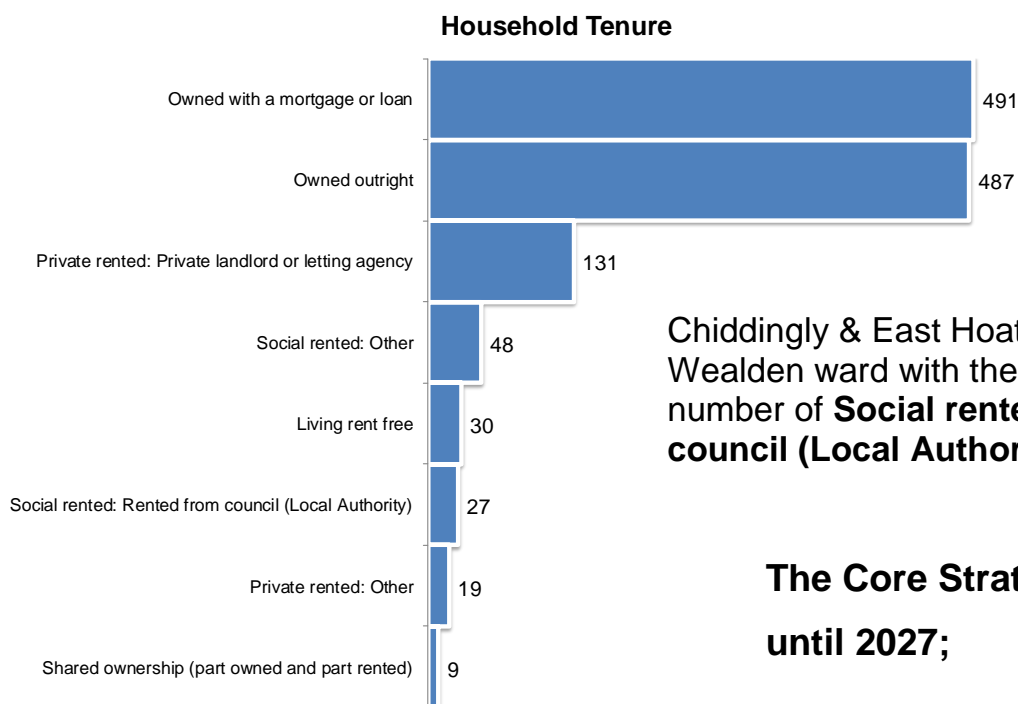
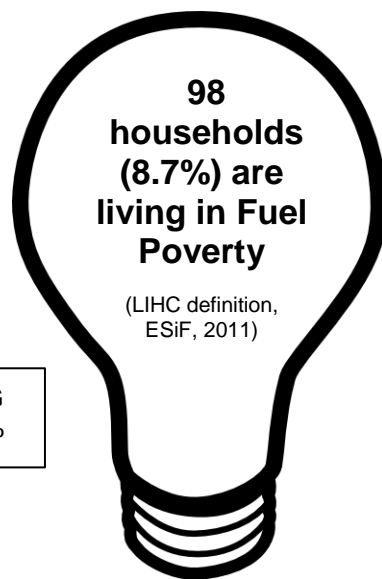
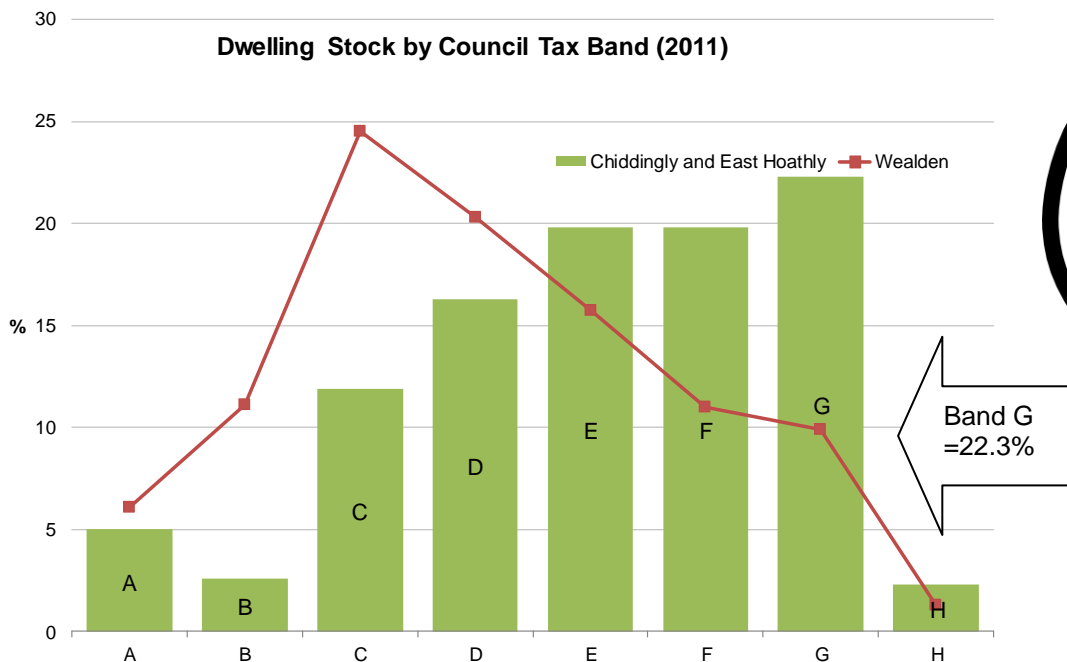
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Housing and Development in Chiddingly and East Hoathly

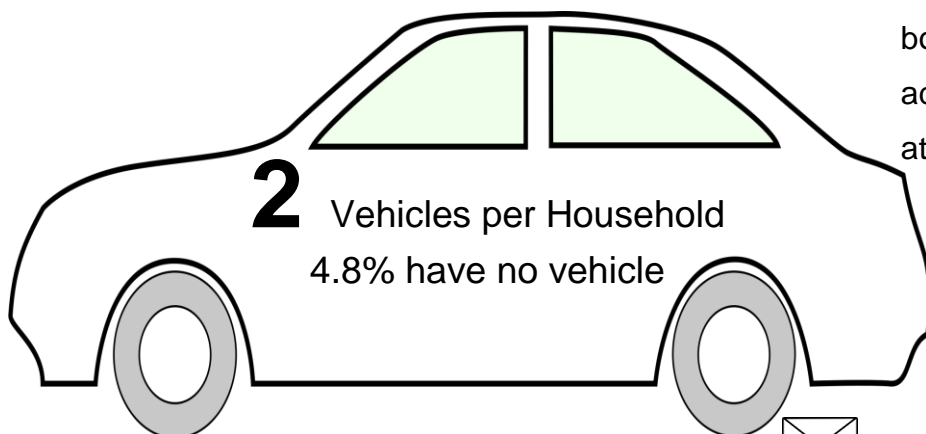
