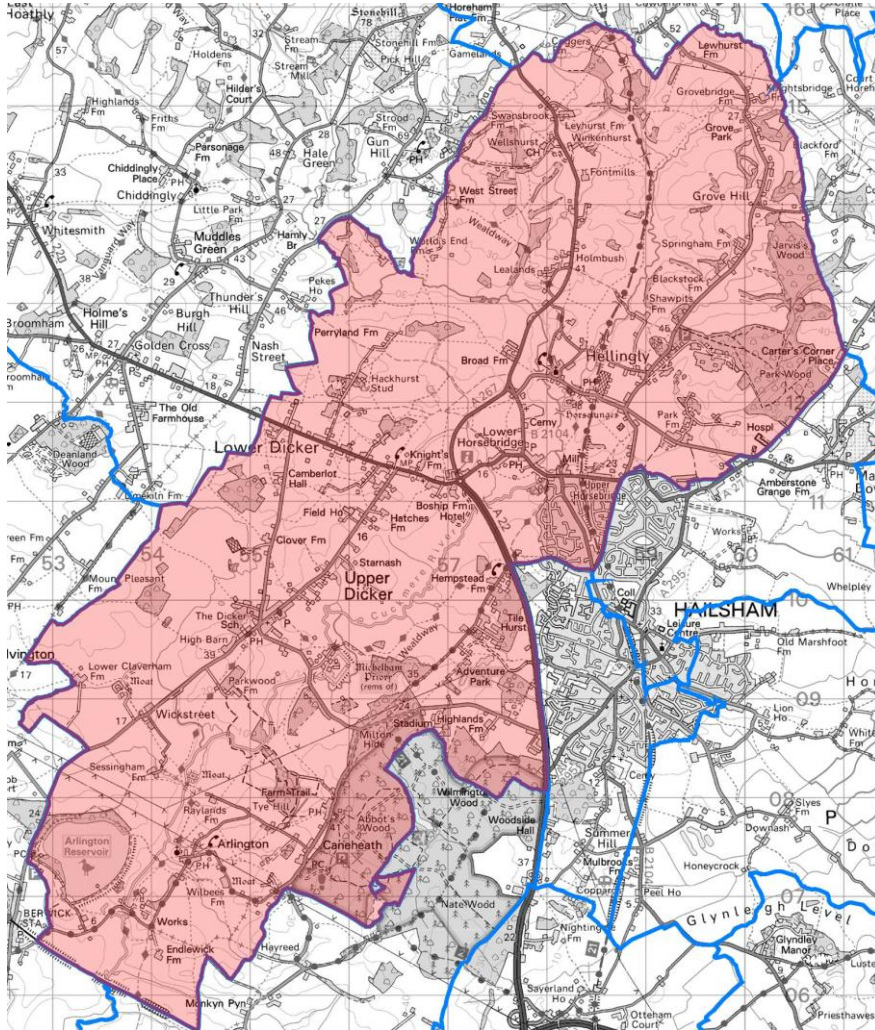


Hellingly Ward profile

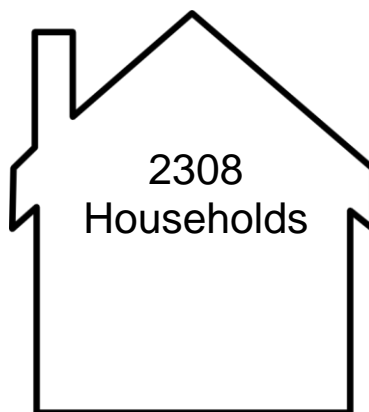

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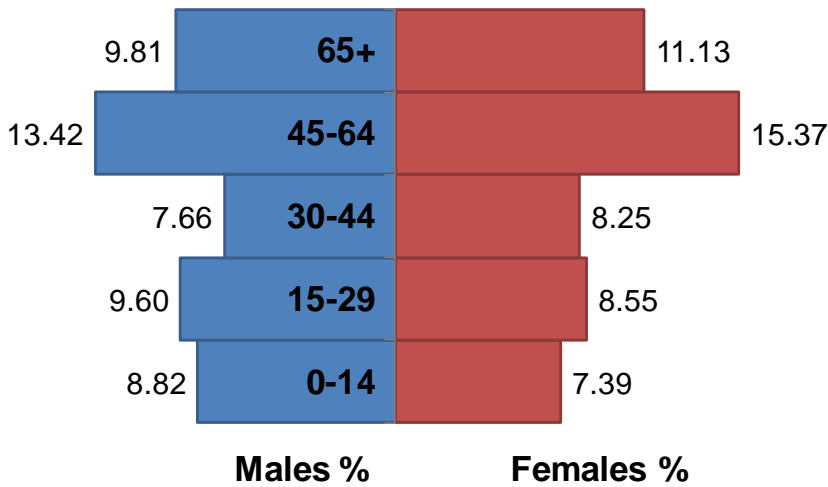


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Who lives in Hellingly?

Population by Age and Gender

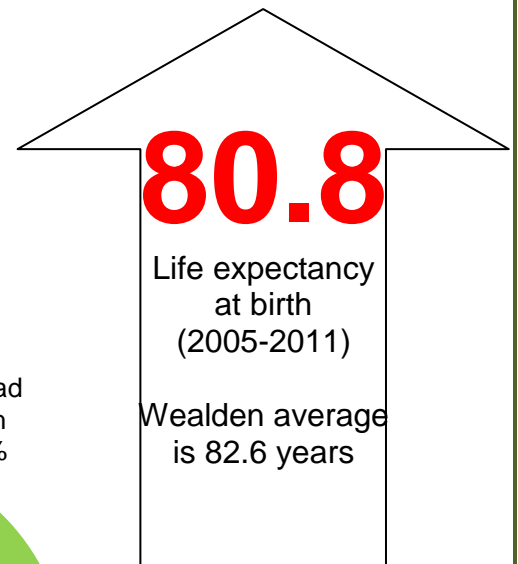
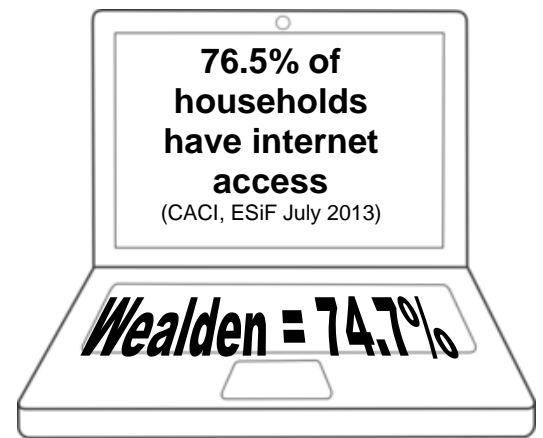
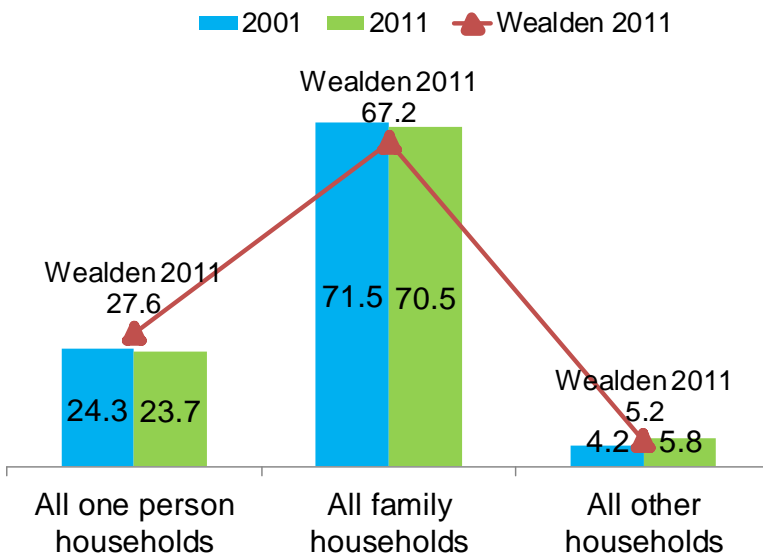


The largest age band is Age 45 to 64.

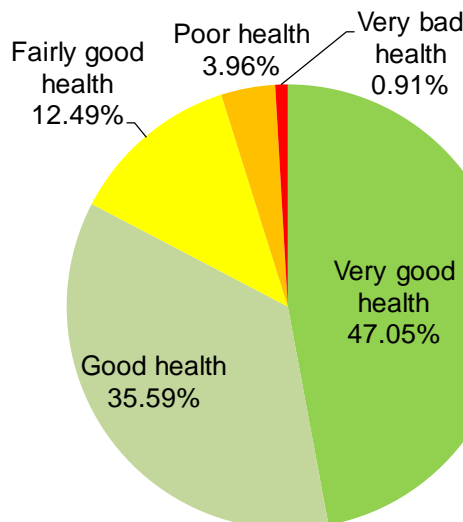
Household Composition in 2001 and 2011 (%)

Hellingly's ranking for the number of residents self assessed as in **very bad health** is 15 (out of 35) within Wealden.



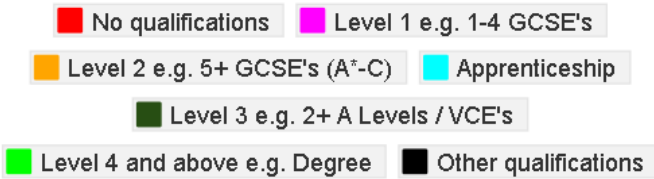
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Education and the Economy in Hellingly

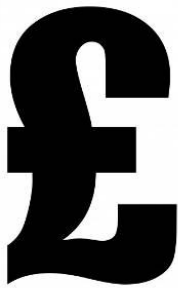

Median household income (£)



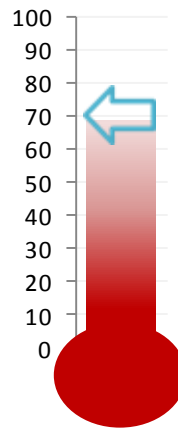
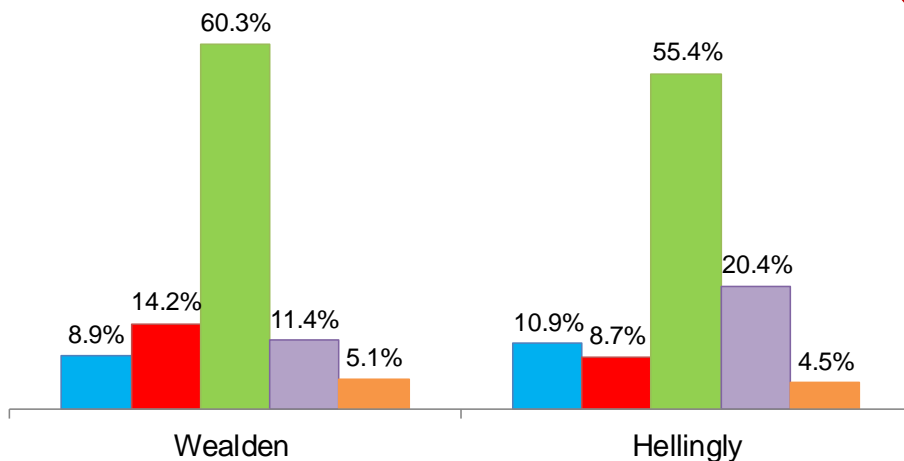
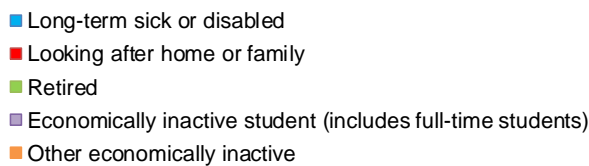
23.8% of households in Hellingly are living in **poverty***

2. Smaller % of Retired and Looking after home or family.



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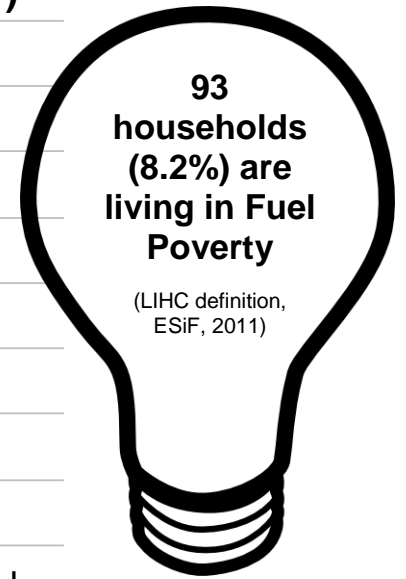
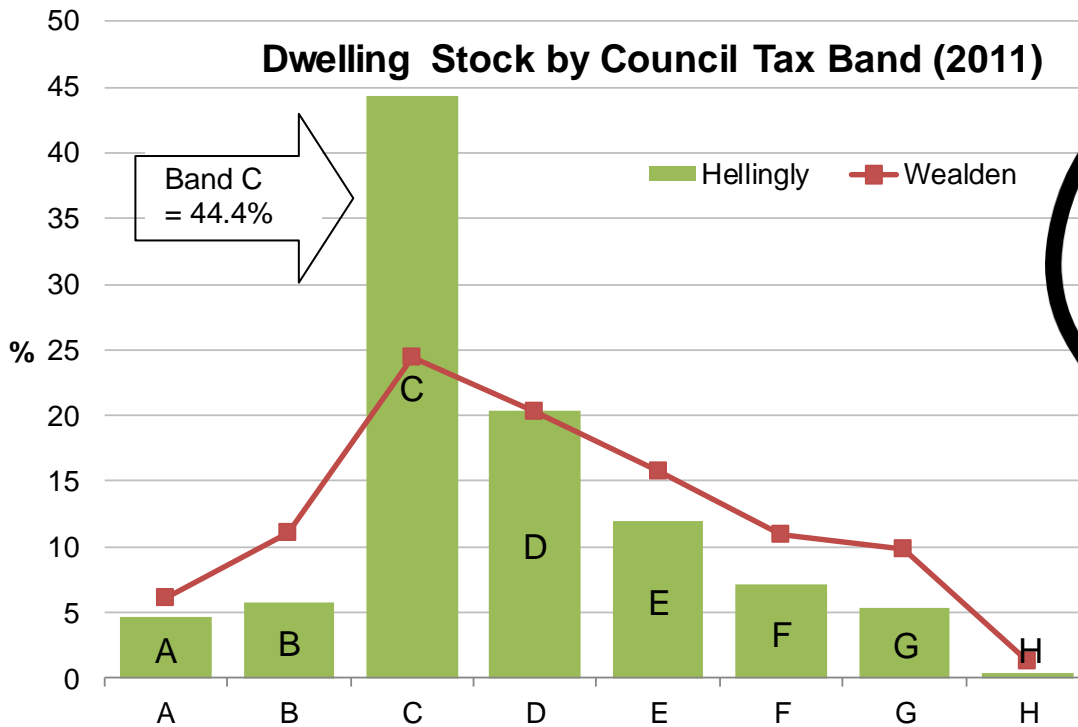


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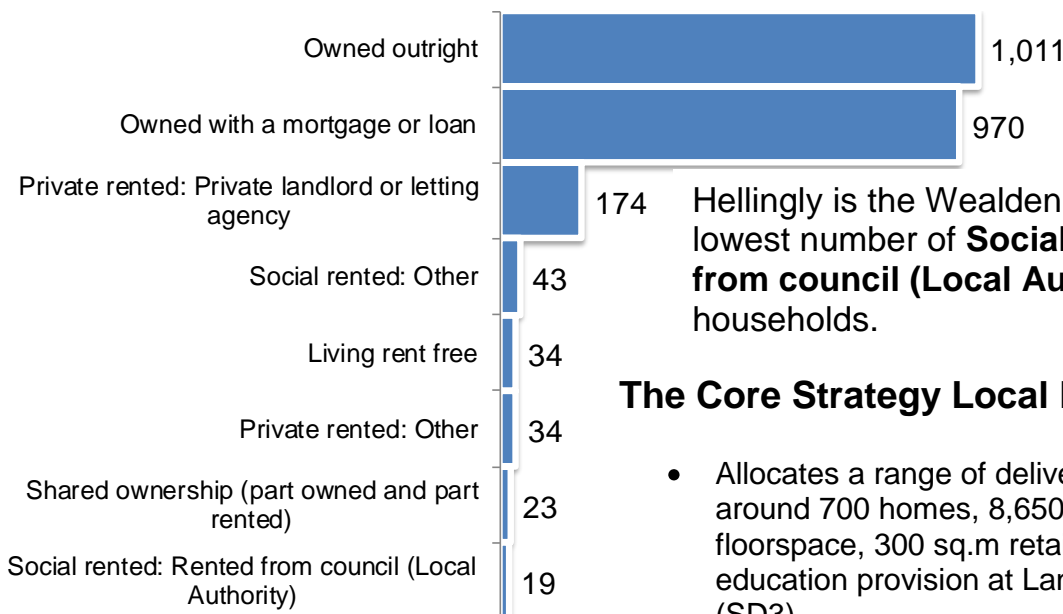
Housing and Development in Hellingly

Dwelling Stock by Council Tax Band (2011)



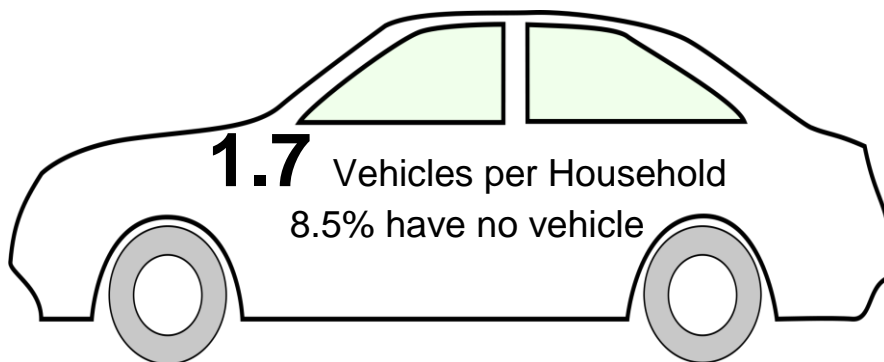
Household Tenure



Hellingly is the Wealden ward with the 6th lowest number of **Social rented: Rented from council (Local Authority)** households.

The Core Strategy Local Plan until 2027;

- Allocates a range of deliverable housing sites for around 700 homes, 8,650 sq.m net employment floorspace, 300 sq.m retail floorspace & education provision at Land at North Hailsham (SD3)
- Allocates 10 additional dwellings at Upper Dicker.



- Will remove the development boundaries as shown in the adopted Wealden Local Plan 1998 at Lower Horsebridge, Upper Dicker & Lower Dicker.
- Classifies Hellingly, Upper Dicker & Lower Horsebridge as Neighbourhood Centres.



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
