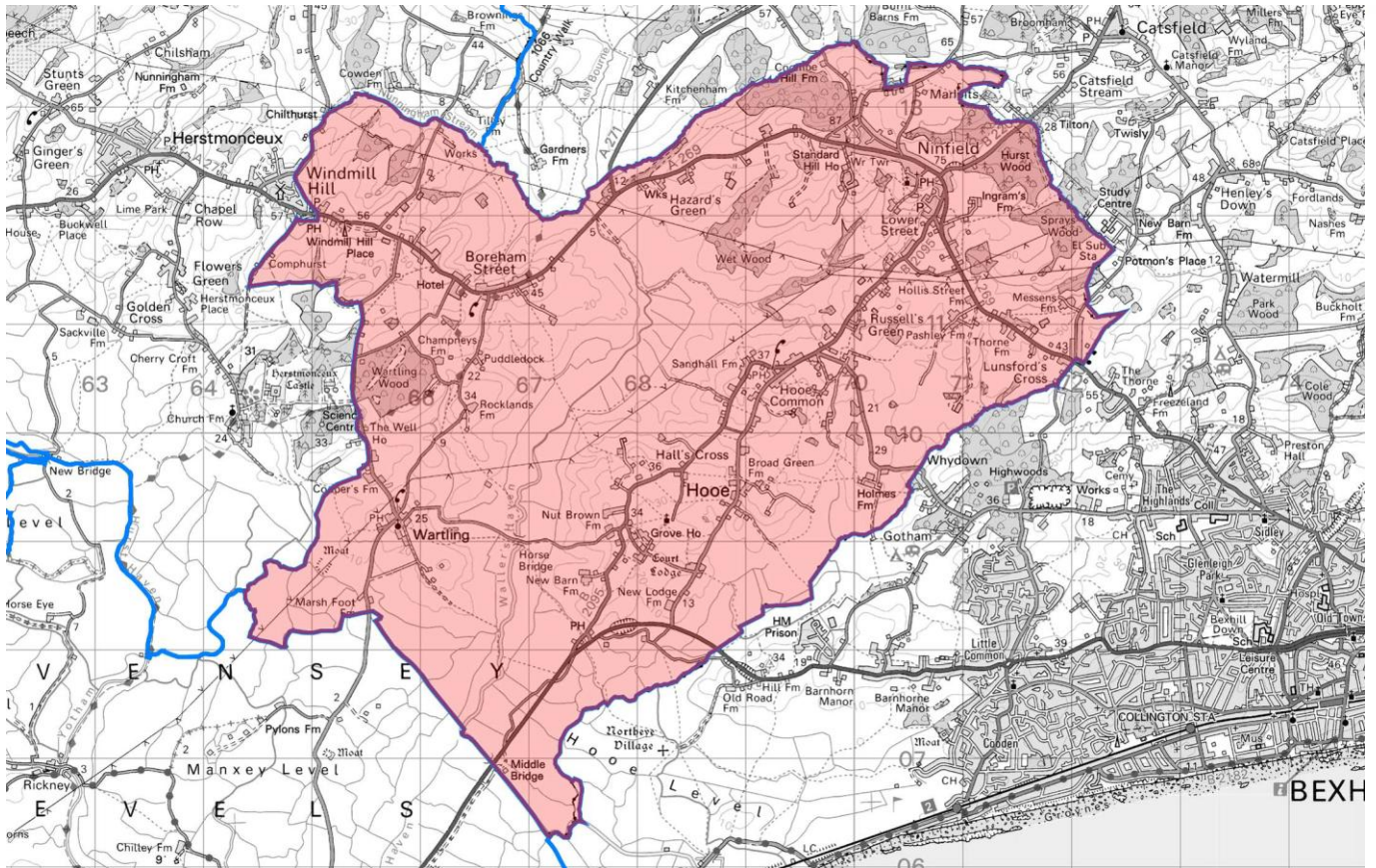


Ninfield and Hooe with Wartling Ward profile

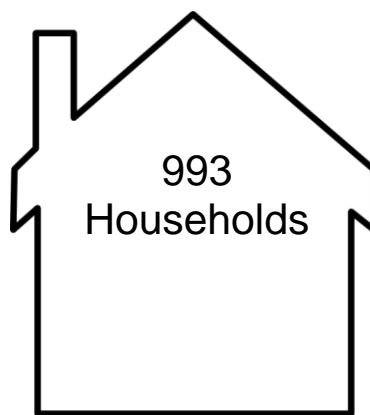

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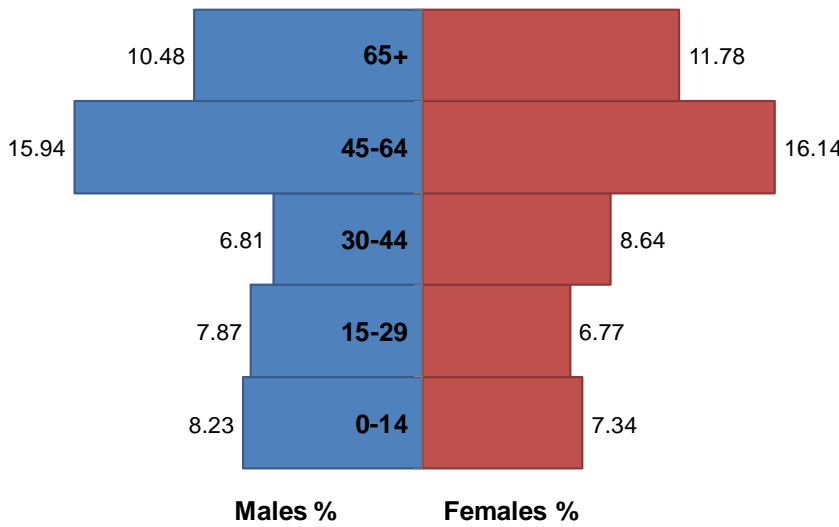


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Who lives in Ninfield and Hooe with Wartling?

Population by Age and Gender

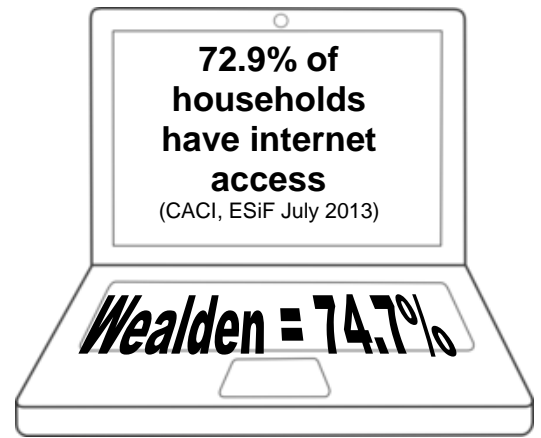
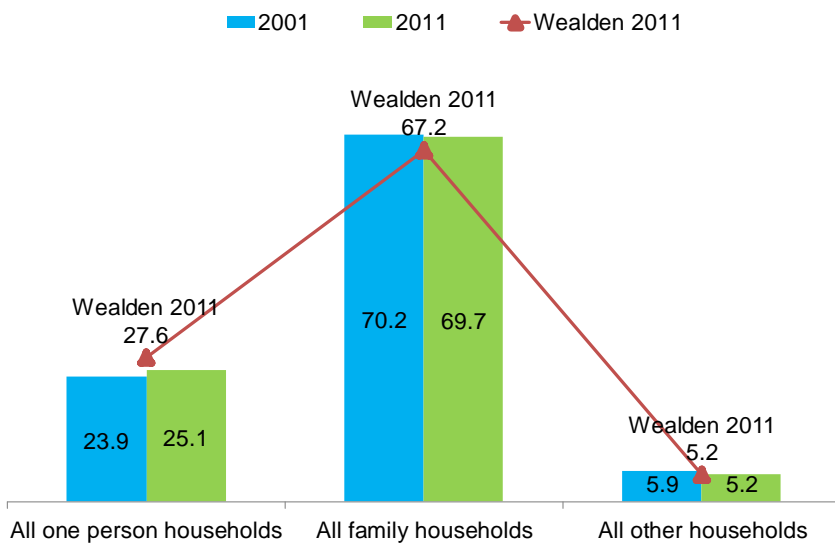


The largest age band is Age 45 to 64.

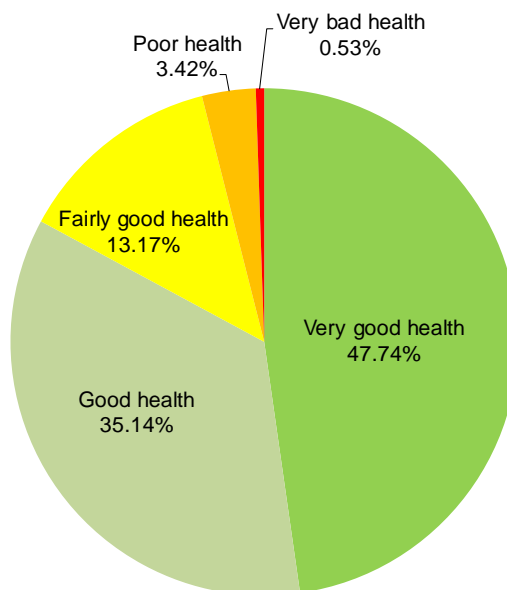
Life expectancy at birth (2005-2011)

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Education and the Economy in Ninfield and Hooe with Wartling

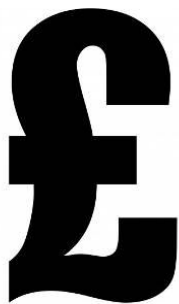

- Level 3 e.g. 2+ A Levels / VCE's
- Level 4 and above e.g. Degree
- Other qualifications

The highest level of educational qualification achieved by the biggest group of Ninfield and Hooe with Wartling residents (28.5%) is Level 4 qualifications and above.

This is similar to the 28.9% of residents aged 16 and over in Wealden with Level 4 qualifications and above.

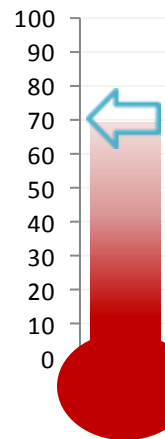
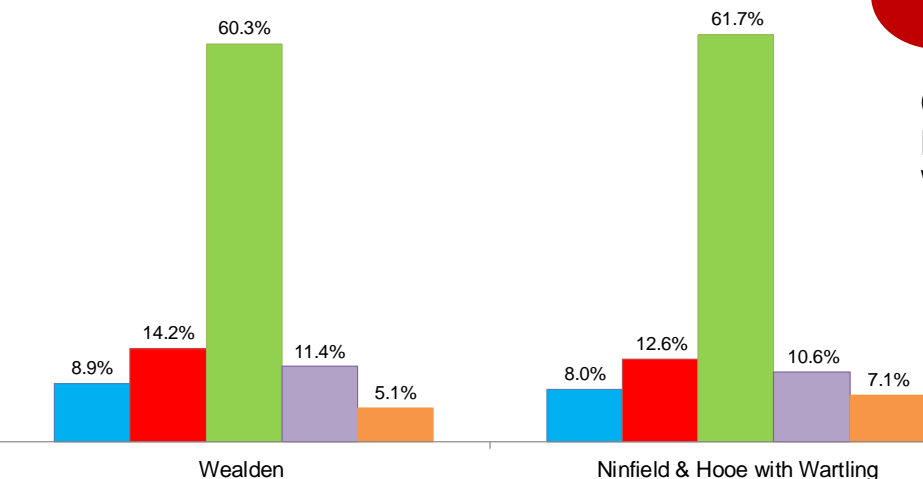


Economic Activity

69.6% of 16 – 74 year olds in Ninfield and Hooe with Wartling are **economically active** (Wealden = 70.1%)

2. Smaller % of Looking after home or family and Economically inactive students.



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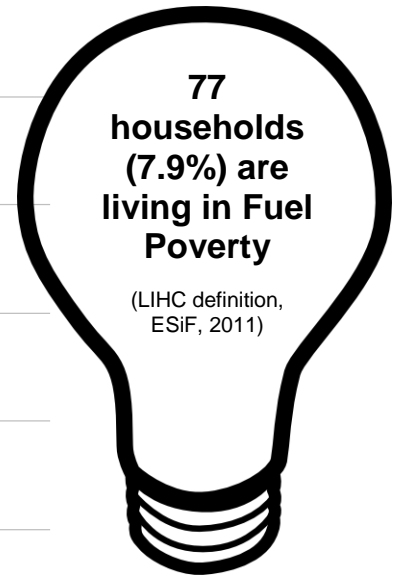
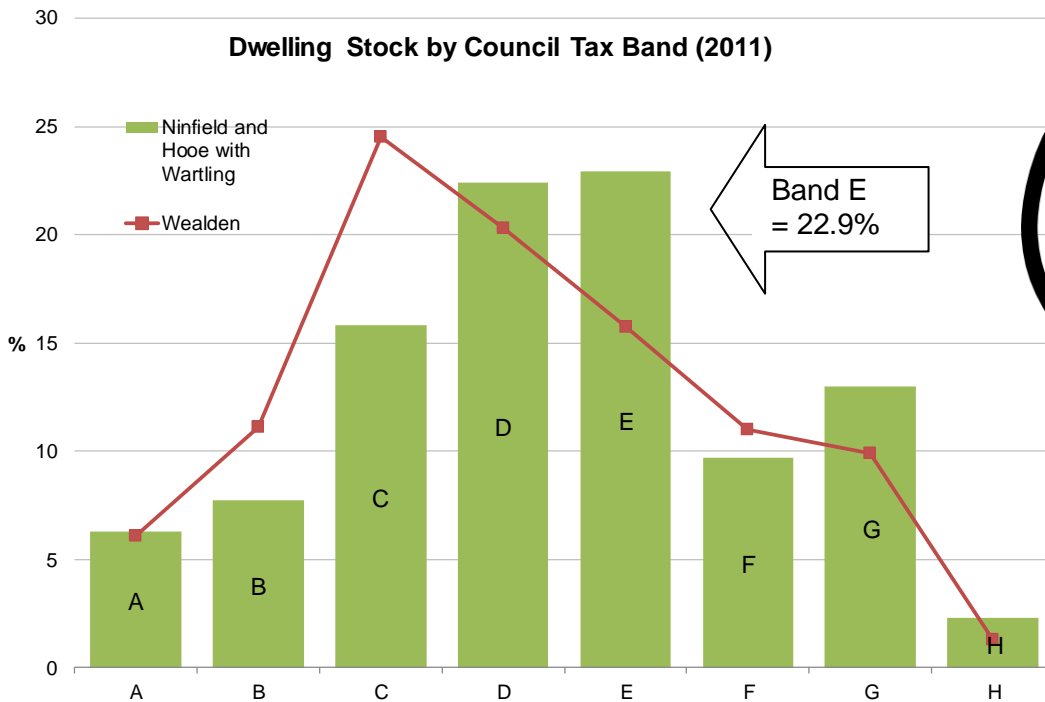


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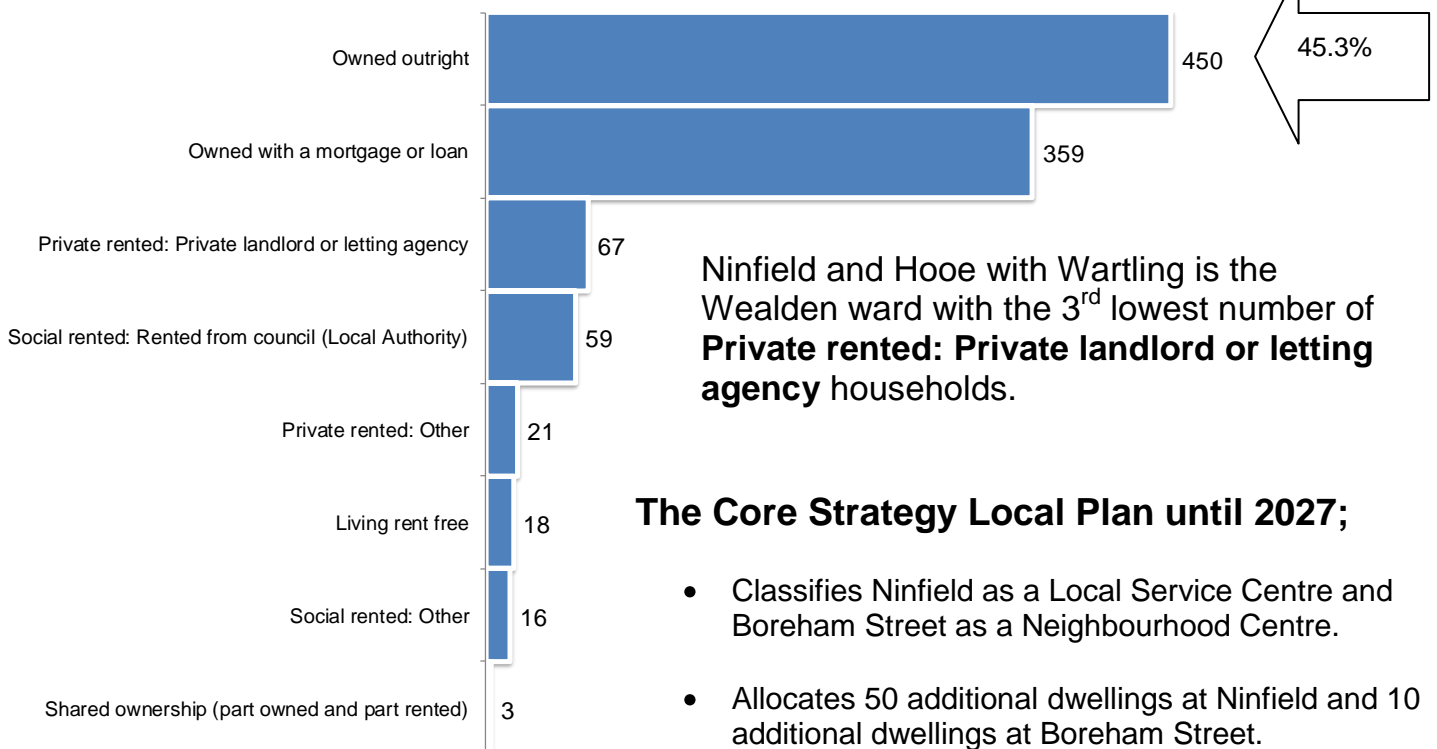
Housing and Development in Ninfield and Hooe with Wartling

Dwelling Stock by Council Tax Band (2011)

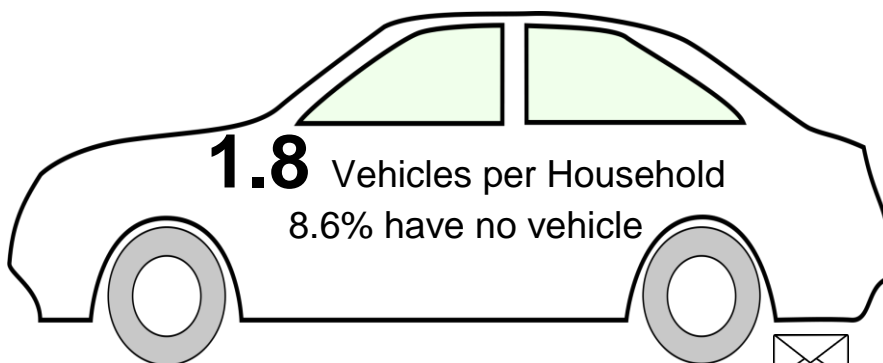


Household Tenure



The Core Strategy Local Plan until 2027;

- Classifies Ninfield as a Local Service Centre and Boreham Street as a Neighbourhood Centre.
- Allocates 50 additional dwellings at Ninfield and 10 additional dwellings at Boreham Street.



- Will retain or provide a development boundary at Ninfield and remove the development boundary as shown in the adopted Wealden Local Plan 1998 at Hooe Common.



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
