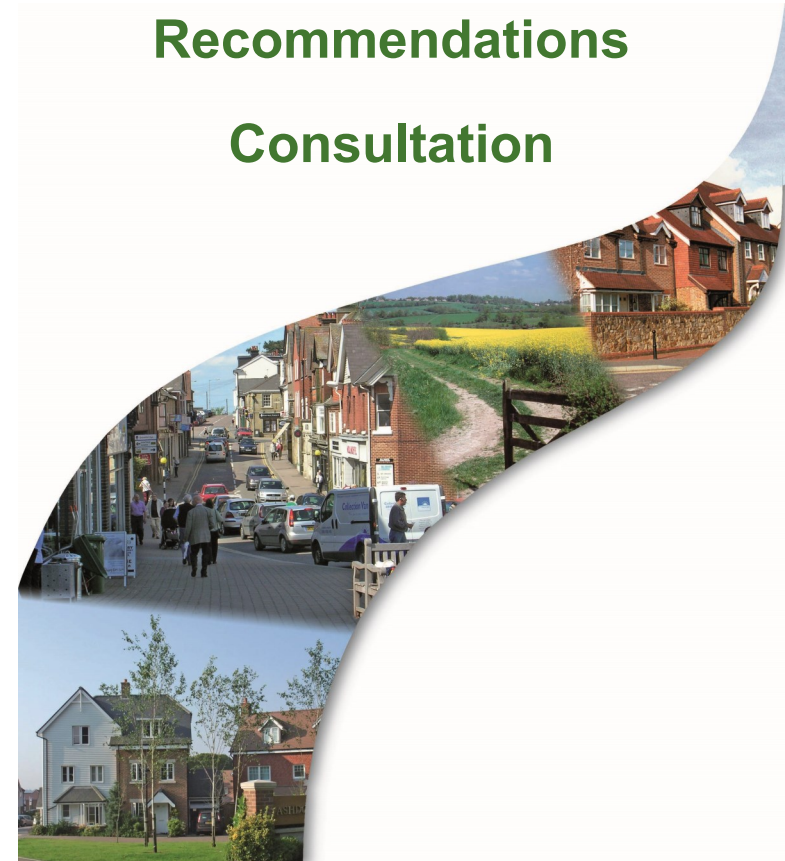

## Introduction

The Council is preparing its new Wealden Local Plan, which aims to review the Council's adopted Core Strategy Local Plan. This plan will identify a vision for the future of the District, set out objectives and establish policies that together will shape the District over the next 22 years.

There are various stages in the Local Plan making process before it can be formally adopted by a Council. The Issues, Options and Recommendations is the first stage of preparation for our new Wealden Local Plan.

In this document, the Council explores issues in the District such as sustainable development, housing growth, the economy and the environment, to name a few.
